

22556VIC COURSE IN THE MANAGEMENT OF ASTHMA RISKS AND EMERGENCIES IN THE WORKPLACE

Description

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to recognise a person having an asthma attack. Additionally, the course will provide you with the knowledge to develop asthma management strategies to prevent exposure to known triggers and minimise the risks related to asthma.

The course is suitable for anyone new to training and for those wanting to update their skills.

Course cost / duration

Cost: \$60.00 per person

Course duration: 2 hours

Group bookings:

Melbourne metropolitan area - minimum course cost is based on a group of 6 people

Victorian country locations - minimum course cost is based on a group of 12 people

Course content

- Recognise signs and symptoms of asthma including the severity of the asthma episode
- Provide appropriate first aid treatment for an asthma attack
- Communicate details of the incident
- Identify individuals at risk of asthma
- Develop risk assessment and emergencies strategies for the workplace



Assessment

A Statement of Attainment will be issued on successful completion of a range of assessments. This includes multiple choice questionnaires, documentation of an incident report, verbal interviews and the observation of practical skills such as following the instructions on an Asthma Action Plan to administer asthma reliever medication in an emergency (using a spacer and a placebo inhaler).
