

## HLTAID003 PROVIDE FIRST AID (LEVEL 2 FIRST AID)

### Description

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to provide basic life support, first aid and incident management until the emergency services arrive.

The course is suitable for anyone new to first aid training and for those wanting to update or refresh their skills.



### Course cost / duration

One day option – Pre-learning required

Two day option – No pre-learning required

### Course content

- Perform the steps of the DRSABCD basic life support action plan
- Use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Management of the unresponsive casualty
- Safe manual handling of a casualty
- Legal responsibilities / duty of care
- Standard precautions for infection control
- Medical emergencies such as: cardiac emergencies, anaphylaxis, asthma, choking, burns, envenomation, head & spinal injuries, bleeding control, fractures, dislocations, soft tissue injuries and hazardous substances

### Assessment

A Statement of Attainment will be issued on successful completion of a range of assessments. This includes written questionnaires, verbal interviews and the observation of practical skills such as following the prompts of an AED, completing CPR on a manikin on the floor, using first aid equipment/resources when providing first aid for asthma, anaphylaxis and envenomation

### Statement of Attainment

All participants must provide a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI) prior to the release of a Statement of Attainment. If you do not have a USI you can create one on [www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au).

The Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) recommends renewing CPR skills on an annual basis. First aid skills should be renewed every three years.

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
