

## HLTAID007 PROVIDE ADVANCED RESUSCITATION

### (ADVANCED RESUSCITATION)

#### DESCRIPTION

*HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation* covers the provision of advanced first aid resuscitation techniques, life support, and management of casualty(s), until the arrival of medical or other assistance, and provision of support to other providers.

#### COURSE COST / DURATION

Course duration: 4 hours (8:30am – 12:30pm)

Victorian country locations - minimum course cost based on 12 people

#### COURSE CONTENT

- CPR
- Prepare resuscitation equipment ready for use
- Administer oxygen
- Operate suction equipment
- Operate manually triggered ventilator (MTV)
- Apply bag and mask resuscitation technique
- Attach and operate an AED
- Restore and maintain equipment ready for future use

#### REQUIREMENTS TO ACHIEVE THE QUALIFICATION

Competence may be demonstrated working either individually, under supervision or as part of a First Aid team.

Assessment will take place in simulated conditions that replicate first aid situations as realistically as possible. Participants will be given scenarios and provided with the appropriate materials to manage the situation. Where necessary this will include first aid equipment and resuscitation manikins.
