

## HLTAID015 PROVIDE ADVANCED RESUSCITATION & OXYGEN THERAPY

### Description

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to provide advanced resuscitation techniques, life support, and the management of a person who is unresponsive and not breathing normally until the emergency services arrive.

The course is suitable for anyone new to advanced resuscitation training and for those wanting to update their skills. This course also applies to anyone who may be required to use specialised equipment to provide resuscitation or oxygen therapy.



### Course cost / duration

Cost: \$190.00 per person

Course duration: 6 hours

#### Group bookings:

Melbourne metropolitan area - minimum course cost is based on a group of 8 people

Victorian country locations - minimum course cost is based on a group of 12 people

### Course content

- Perform the steps of the DRSABCD basic life support action plan
- Use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Management of the unresponsive casualty
- Legal responsibilities / duty of care
- Standard precautions for infection control
- Benefits and complications when providing oxygen
- Use specialised equipment such as: oxygen therapy equipment, oropharyngeal airways, Bag Valve Masks (BVMs), suction devices, tourniquets and haemostatic dressings

### Assessment

A Statement of Attainment will be issued on successful completion of a range of assessments. This may include written questionnaires, verbal interviews and the observation of practical skills such as following the prompts of an AED, completing CPR on a manikin on the floor, and using specialised oxygen and first aid equipment.
