

HLTAID009 PROVIDE CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR)

Description

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to recognise a person who is unresponsive and not breathing normally, and to provide CPR until the emergency services arrive.

The course is suitable for anyone new to CPR training and for those wanting to update their skills.



Course cost / duration

Cost: \$65.00 per person

Duration: 2.5 hours

Course content

- Chain of Survival
- Perform the steps of the DRSABCD basic life support action plan
- Use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Management of the unresponsive casualty
- Safe manual handling of a casualty
- Legal responsibilities / duty of care
- Standard precautions for infection control

Assessment

A Statement of Attainment will be issued on successful completion of a range of assessments. This includes pre-course online learning tasks, verbal interviews and the observation of practical skills such as following the prompts of an AED and completing CPR on a manikin on the floor.
